A Brief Historical Overview


In 1902 a world première took place: the first motor race on a circuit starting and finishing at the same place. This innovation that began with the Circuit des Ardennes was the inspiration for all the major races that soon followed (Gordon Bennett, Targa Florio, etc.) and subsequently also led to the creation of the circuit at Spa-Francorchamps.

The creator of the Circuit des Ardennes was the great sportsman Baron Pierre de Crawhez, who won the race in 1903. The other editions were won by George Heath (GB) on Panhard, Hemery (F) on Darracq, Duray (B/F) on Lorraind Dietrich, and Lord Moore-Brabazon (GB) on Minerva. Numerous other marques competed on the Circuit: de Dion Bouton, Mercedes, Pipe, Germain, Hotchkiss, Napier, Clément, Wolseley, Mors, Fiat, etc.

Among the competitors on two wheels were such names as: Osmont on de Dion tricycle, Demeester on Griffon,

Kühling on Minerva. Other motorcycles included Peugeot, Sarolea, Antoine, FN and many others.

In 2002 the first Commemoration of the Centenary of the Circuit des Ardennes took place under the patronage of H.M. King Albert II of Belgium and was a great success both for the participants and the numerous spectators. The Commemorations held in 2005, 2008 and 2011 were even more successful: some 100 vehicles from before 1908 and over 500 other classic vehicles took part in this historic motoring festival.

The Commemorations of the Circuit des Ardennes

The 2014 Commemoration will further expand the programme with different routes from previous years, just as the original Circuits varied the itinerary from year to year.

Thus in 2014 for the first time you will negotiate the famous corner at Langlier which will be specially prepared and decorated.

'The heart of the Ardennes'

The Circuit passes through a marvellous natural region that has scarcely changed since the early 1900s: the heart of the Belgian Ardennes. (The route passes through the magnificent Forest of Anlier, for example, and on the Sunday through Chiny and Bouillon).

This non-competitive event will follow the historic circuit in the spirit of a popular grande fête automobile, reuniting enthusiasts of all ancient vehicles on two, three and four wheels.



General conditions of participation

The participant acknowledges that in registering to take part in this event he/she accepts without reserve the conditions set out below.

This event is a meeting of ancient vehicles, from the origins up to 1970 (motorcycles up to 1960), consisting of an excursion on the major road sections used by the Circuit des Ardennes at the beginning of the 20th century.

The event is held in a spirit of good humour and being of a strictly non-competitive nature neither sporting classification nor complaints will be considered.

The participating vehicle and its driver must fulfil the legal traffic requirements in Belgium, in particular:

- The vehicle must be registered for use on the road
- The vehicle must be covered by third-party insurance
- The vehicle must be in good mechanical condition and suitable for road use
- The driver must hold a valid driving licence

At their discretion the organisers may verify the vehicle's condition, authenticity and conformity as stated on the registration form.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse the entry of any vehicle that does not meet the above requirements – their decision is final.

The organisers recommend that the driver and passengers clothe themselves appropriately for the prevailing conditions. Period costume is recommended but not obligatory and those so dressed will receive a special welcome.

The driver and passengers agree to follow the instructions of the police and the organisers and their representatives (identified by an armband) at all times.

The organisers reserve the right to modify the programme of the Commemoration, if necessary without advance warning, according to the prevailing circumstances and opportunities.


For reasons of organisation, publication and safety, no vehicle may start in a different category from that in which it was entered.

Military vehicles are not accepted (other than motorcycles up to 1918).

The application of these conditions will be conducted under the control of the Organising and Historical Committees of the ASBL Circuit des Ardennes Historique and of the Technical Committee of the Royal Veteran Car Club Belgium.

Cancellation policy: 50% of the registration fee will be reimbursed if cancellation is received in writing before 15 May 2014. No refund is possible after that date or if the vehicle fails to start.

NB The organisers will define the vehicle category based on the information supplied by the participant, whose signature on the entry form engages his/her responsibility for the exactitude of that information. The organisers reserve the right to refuse the entry of any vehicle whose specification differs from the stated information. The organisers' decision is final. The participant declares hereby that he/she unreservedly accepts the General Conditions.
